Tuition Fees	No tuition fees applicable for Erasmus students.

French language courses	<p>Our courses are practice based for Erasmus students who would not speak French. All the teachers and assistants (except Graphic Design department) dispense their classes in English to foreign students. Some theoretical courses in Master 1 are in English.</p> <p>If a student wants to learn French, He/she/they can ask the Erasmus office for help and information before choosing an appropriate course.</p>
